Visit Medina of Tunis: Sidi Ben Arous Street; Zitouna Mosque; Kasbah Square

Visit Sidi Bousaid: The Café des Nattes;

Visit Sejnane – Echkeul & Mateur

Visit Sousse – El Djem – Sfax & Kerkennah

Sousse: Explore the UNESCO-listed Medina of Sousse;

Sfax : Historical Dramas: Sfax's long history ; Sfax's bustling markets, vibrant neighborhoods, and diverse population

Explore The Kerkennah Islands

Kerkennah – Matemata Toujane & Ksar Jouemaa

Matemata: The troglodyte homes of Matmata offer a unique architectural marvel, providing natural insulation against the desert heat; exploring its underground dwellings, learning about Berber culture, and experiencing the desert landscape.

Matmata gained international fame as a filming location for Star Wars Episode IV: A New Hope, featuring the iconic underground home of Luke Skywalker.

Toujane: Toujane offers stunning panoramic views of the surrounding desert landscape, with its terraced hillsides and traditional architecture; Toujane has served as a filming location for movies and television shows, showcasing its unique beauty and cultural heritage to audiences around the world.

Guest House Dar Ennaim: Nestled in the heart of the Dahar mountains, it offers an authentic experience by allowing visitors to stay in traditional troglodyte dwellings. The guesthouse is situated within a permaculture farm, providing a peaceful setting close to local homes and agricultural operations.

Kairouan: Islamic Heritage, one of the most important Islamic cities in North Africa, renowned for its craftsmanship, including carpet weaving, pottery, and brassware, which are showcased in local workshops and markets.
